

Terms and conditions for the 2009 Primelocation.com Blog Awards

1. This competition is run by The Digital Property Group (The Promoter).
2. Under 16s must obtain permission from a parent or guardian to enter.
3. Not open to employees and families of The Digital Property Group or anyone else connected with the creation or administration of the competition.
4. By participating in the competition (whether you have nominated a blog or agreed to your blog being shortlisted), you consent to The Digital Property Group disclosing any personal information submitted by you to the Promoter for use by the Promoter and its authorised agents as necessary to administer the promotion. Any personal data submitted by you will be used solely in accordance with current UK data protection legislation and the privacy policies of The Digital Property Group.
5. Votes on the nominations must be made before midnight on 31st January 2010.
6. There is no responsibility taken for entries lost, delayed or incomplete, or incorrect email or postal addresses.
7. Winners will be selected from all the nominations received by the Promoter. There will be a maximum of one winner per category (so a maximum of 4 winners in total). The judges will select up to 6 blogs for the 'best newcomer category', which will be open to a public vote until midnight on 31st January 2010. Shortlists will be posted on the blog for the remaining 3 categories, but the winner of these will be decided by The Digital Property Group based on inventiveness, originality, artistic value and quality.
8. The decision of the judges is final.
9. Winners will be announced on or after Monday 1st February 2010 (within 7 days of this date) and be contacted by email as well as being posted online at www.primelocation.com.
